Steel's legal, regulatory, compliance, corporate governance, environmental affairs, security, aircraft, and labor and employment matters. Ms. Folsom, who joined U. S. Steel in January 2014, is a key member of the executive management team who also spearheads the company's worldwide public policy and government affairs initiatives. In addition, Ms. Folsom is responsible for ensuring the profitability of the USS Real Estate division as well as managing the company's joint ventures worldwide.

Ms. Folsom is playing a key leadership role in U. S. Steel's current commitment to achieving significantly reinvigorated business growth, due largely to a long-established record for transformative action throughout her career. In addition, Ms. Folsom is focused on ensuring the company's transformation efforts are simultaneously informed by comprehensive oversight mechanisms to mandate compliance and ensure accountability.

Prior to joining U. S. Steel, Ms. Folsom was Executive Vice President, General Counsel and Chief Compliance Officer of ACADEMI LLC, a leading global security provider to the federal government and commercial clients. Her transformative work there continues to be recognized as a gold standard for compliance and accountability. Previously, Ms. Folsom was Deputy General Counsel and Chief Regulatory and Compliance Officer for the American International Group (AIG), where she established and implemented best-in-class regulatory and compliance processes during the height of the economic crisis. Ms. Folsom was also Counselor to the President of the World Bank Group and Director of its Department of Institutional Integrity, where she led that organization's global anti-corruption program.

Among her earlier positions, Ms. Folsom was Special Counsel at O'Melveny & Myers LLP; Chief of Staff to Her Majesty Queen Noor of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan; Special Assistant to First Lady Barbara Bush; and Chief of Staff to Co-Chairman of the Republican National Committee Maureen Reagan.

Ms. Folsom is the recipient of multiple awards, both for specific successes and career achievements. In 2015, she was named a recipient of the Aiming High Award – one of only 90 women leaders who have been so honored in

Among her many other professional activities, Ms. Folsom serves on the advisory board of Global Leaders in Law and the Global Issues Forum Committee of the Association of Corporate Counsel's Washington Metropolitan Area Corporate Counsel.

Sarah Morgenthau joined the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) as the Executive Director of the Homeland Security Advisory Council (HSAC) in February 2015. In April 2016, she also became the Deputy Assistant Secretary for the Private Sector Office. Ms. Morgenthau advises the Secretary on the impact of the Department's policies, regulations, and processes on private sector companies, universities, and not for profit institutions, and enhances strategic communications to foster better collaboration between the private and public sectors on homeland security issues. As Executive Director, Ms. Morgenthau oversees the HSAC, and the ongoing policy work of the subcommittees, including the Foreign Fighter Task Force, the DHS Employee Task Force, the DHS Grant Review Task Force, the CBP Integrity Advisory Panel, the Cybersecurity Subcommittee, and the Countering Violent Extremism Subcommittee. She also coordinates closely with the Aspen Institute Homeland Security Group.

Prior to her appointment at DHS, Ms. Morgenthau spent five years at the Peace Corps where she was Director of Peace Corps Response, a program that deploys technically skilled volunteers for short term assignments in education, health and HIV/AIDS, business and NGO development, information technology, youth development, agriculture, environment and disaster preparedness and response. Ms. Morgenthau also led the roll-out of the Global Health Service Partnership, the Peace Corps' first public-private partnership that addresses the shortage of qualified health professionals in developing countries.

In 2007-08, Ms. Morgenthau was actively engaged in the Obama for America Campaign and served on the National Finance Committee. In addition, she was a founding member of Women for Obama and then served as New Jersey state director of Women for Obama. In 2006, Ms. Morgenthau was the scheduler for then Mayor Cory Booker on his campaign in Newark, New Jersey.

Ms. Morgenthau's legal experience includes working as a litigation attorney with Curtis-Mallet, Prevost and Mosle, a New York City law firm; as a staff attorney in the Enforcement Division of the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, also in New York City; and as a law clerk for Joseph A. Greenaway Jr., then a United States District Court judge in New Jersey. Ms. Morgenthau has a bachelor's degree in political science from Barnard College and a law degree from the Columbia University School of Law.
